


Reconstruct the Pot



Cut the pieces out carefully, reconstruct the pot, then glue them onto a clean piece of paper.

Most pottery found on archaeological excavations is found as small pieces called sherds. Occasionally there are enough pieces from the same pot, or a pot with very interesting decoration to make it worthwhile piecing it together again. This kind of pot was made at the pottery at Norton in the early 4th century A.D. It is sometimes called a 'smith pot' can you think why? What do you think it was used for?
